

## GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

### **ORI11BA08I - Design and construction of the Sewerage Network and Wastewater Treatment Plant of Bijeljina City – Bosnia and Herzegovina**

The City of Bijeljina in Republic of Srpska (Bosnia and Herzegovina) intends using a fund made available by the Netherlands Enterprise Agency (RVO.nl, Rijksdienst Voor Ondernemend Nederland) and the City of Bijeljina Budget to procure Works for the construction of sewerage networks in the City of Bijeljina in line with European norms.

The project concerns the construction of wastewater collection infrastructure in the town of Bijeljina, a city with approximately 115,000 inhabitants.

With the construction of about 32 km of main collectors, sewers, storm water drains and approximately 2,500 house connections, the aim is to cover 40,000 population equivalents in the town centre and adjacent neighbourhoods.

The approximate scope of works is:

#### Zone 1, 3, 4, 8 & 10

Sewerage network extension HDPE-100, DN200 to DN500: 9,710-m

#### Zone 2:

Sewerage network construction, HDPE-100, DN250 to DN630: 4,625-m

Rainwater drainage system, HDPE-100, DN315 to DN630: 1,262-m

Rainwater drainage system, Concrete pipe, DN700 465-m

#### Zone 5:

Sewerage network construction, HDPE-100, DN250 to DN630: 3,496-m

Rainwater drainage system, HDPE-100, DN315 to DN500: 940-m

Rainwater drainage system, Concrete pipe, DN700 363-m

#### Zone 6:

Sewerage network construction, HDPE-100, DN250 to DN630: 5,118-m

Rainwater drainage system, HDPE-100, DN315 to DN500: 459-m

Rainwater drainage system, Concrete pipe, DN700 to DN1200 958-m

#### Zone 7:

Sewerage network construction, HDPE-100, DN250 to DN680: 4,654-m

Rainwater drainage system, HDPE-100, DN315 to DN500: 1,009-m

Rainwater drainage system, Concrete pipe, DN700 to DN1400 781-m

In addition to providing adequate and reliable wastewater services to the citizens of Bijeljina, other objectives of the Project are:

- the protection of the town's source of potable water from contamination and
- the protection of surface water in and around Bijeljina from pollution, i.e. the Dašnica canal and the Sava River.

The tender procedures will be subject to EBRD's Procurement Policies and Rules and will be open to firms from any country.

Specific procurement notices for contracts to be bid under the EBRD tender procedures will be announced, as they become available, in Nezavisne Novine (local newspaper), at A.D. "Vodovod
